The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) helps low-income working people, senior citizens, the disabled and other feed their families.

What can I purchase with SNAP?

Food for your household to eat, such as:

- breads and cereals
- fruits and vegetables
- · meats, fish and poultry
- dairy products

You can also purchase seeds and plants, which produce food for your household to eat.

What can't I purchase with SNAP?

- beer, wine, liquor, cigarettes or tobacco
- any nonfood items, such as: pet food, soap, paper products, household supplies, vitamins and medicine
- food that will be eaten in the store
- hot foods

NYC SANITATION OFFICAL NOTICE

Please remember, beginning November 12, 2024, all trash must be set out in a garbage bin, fifty-five gallons or less, with a secure lid. This applies to all homeowners.

Please note, that this bin requirements only apply to regular garbage and <u>not to recyclables</u>.

You can use a compliant bin, fifty-five gallons or less with a secure lid, that you already have.

However, starting in June 2026, you MUST use an Official NYC Bin.

Official NYC Bins are only available for purchase online at: www.bins.nyc. Multiple sizes are available and different colors for your recyclables, the price is below \$50.

105 AND 116 PRECINCT NEWS

THE CREEDMOOR HUMANITARIAN EMERGENCY RESPONSE AND RELIEF CENTER

In early October, after two fugitives wanted in Florida were captured at the Creedmoor migrant shelter, elected officials reignited calls to close the Humanitarian Emergency Response and Relief Center (HERRC) due to safety concerns. The elected officials were joined by community leaders, including members from Queens Village Civic, near the site hours after hearing the news of the arrests.

In the aftermath of the incident above and the communities and elected officials prompt response, metal detectors have been placed at Creedmoor. While this is a welcome announcement, we are still concerned about other issues regarding the HERRC.


