Recently, the concrete medians in front of Martin Van Buren High School were transformed into catch basins with beautiful foliage to trap the runoff water (Rain / Snow). This of course is designed to prevent flooding in the surrounding areas. According to our mayor, this water trapping system will be replicated throughout our city.

However, several homeowners in Queens Village are removing all the grass lawns, trees, and shrubs on their property. They are replacing them with concrete or pavers which may look nice but goes against our Department Of Building codes. This illegal action add stress on our water management infrastructure system to its limit and more seriously creates flooding in the surrounding yards in the area. 

Proposals on the Ballot in this November General Election

- 1. Adds Certain Protections to the State Bill of Rights Adds anti-discrimination provisions to State Constitution.
- 2. Cleaning Public Property amend the City Charter to expand and clarify the Department of Sanitation's power to clean streets and other City property and require disposal of waste in containers.
- 3. Additional Estimates of the Cost of the Proposed Laws and Updates to Budget Deadlines require fiscal analysis from the Council before hearings and votes on laws
- 4. More Notice and Time Before Votes on Public Safety Legislation
- 5. Capital Planning require more detail in the annual assessment of City facilities
- 6. Minority and Women-Owned Business Enterprise (MWBES), Film Permits, and Archive Review Boards to establish the Chief Business Diversity Officer.

Please remember, beginning November 12, 2024, all trash must be set out in a garbage bin, fifty-five gallons or less, with a secure lid. This applies to all homeowners.

Please note, that this bin requirements only apply to regular garbage and not to recyclables.

You can use a compliant bin, fifty-five gallons or less with a secure lid, that you already have.

However, starting in June 2026, you MUST use an Official NYC Bin.

Official NYC Bins are only available for purchase online at: www.bins.nyc. Multiple sizes are available and different colors for your recyclables, the price is below \$50.


