#### Dear Neighbors,

As we prepare for more beautiful weather, we must continue being more vigilant about our safety. I know the migrant crisis will not disappear overnight and I am hoping that our elected officials will address the lawlessness and restore sanity to our Immigration system. Members, if you encountered any incidents, please reported it via 311.

The Mayor have asked our city council members to approve a bill referred to as "City of Yes." There are 18 zoning items that our Mayor want changed or eliminated including requesting a variance to build something that's not zoned for, to "as of right to build". Should the full measure of this proposal be approved, it will change our City and Village dramatically.

The New Queens Bus Route designs are in their final stages of data collection and input by the public. Several existing Bus Routes will be changed or eliminated affecting thousands of daily commuters. QVCA took active participation from its inception of data gathering and have continued doing so on behalf of our residents. Please see page 3 for information on how you can participate.

Recently at Jamaica Ave and Springfield Blvd eastbound, the NYC Department of Transportation changed the flow of traffic by eliminating left turns at this intersection. The NYC-DOT need restore the left turn.

### THE CREEDMOOR HUMANITARIAN EMERGENCY RESPONSE AND RELIEF CENTER

The Mayor's Office and NYC Health + Hospitals recently announced that the migrant facility will be implementing a curfew effective on April 15. The curfew, which limits migrants from coming or going between 11 p.m. and 6 a.m. each night with exemptions for work and emergencies.

The 105th Pct continue to station an officer 24/7 at the entrance and NCOs are giving the site special attention. The children's playground near PS 18 is being monitored by the 105th and adults without a kid are not allowed in the park.

### QUEENS BUS NETWORK REDESIGN – FINAL PLAN

The Queens Bus Network Redesign is an innovative and comprehensive initiative aimed at enhancing the bus commuting experience for Queens residents. This plan signifies the Mass Transit Authority (MTA) commitment to making bus travel more efficient, accessible, and responsive to our riders' needs.

In December 2023, a Proposed Final Plan was released. The MTA will continue with stakeholders outreach through the Spring 2024.

The redesign team will host open houses close to Queens Village on the dates listed from 5 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

#### **DINING OUT NYC**

The City recently released the final rules for the city's permanent outdoor dining program, "Dining Out NYC." The new rules layout clear guidance for restaurant owners as they work to create new set-ups based on the new rules. The final rules prioritize equity, expanding access to safe, clean outdoor dining in all five boroughs. The following is what will be allowed:

- Roadway cafés, which are located in the curb lane or parking lane fronting a ground-floor restaurant, will only be permitted from April 1 through Nov. 29.
- Sidewalk cafés, which are located on a public sidewalk or sidewalk widening that fronts a groundfloor restaurant, will be permitted year-round.


