PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear Neighbors,

I hope you were not affected by the record-breaking rainfall a few weeks ago. Please note that Daylight Saving Time is scheduled to end on Sunday, November 5.

The Humanitarian Emergency Response and Relief Center (HERRC) at Creedmoor Psychiatric Center is operating with minimal negative impact on the community. The Commanding Officer of the 105 precinct, Inspector Igor Pinkhasov, reports that the immigrants at Creedmoor , apart from a few reports of them entering private yards to retrieve refundable bottles , have caused no serious incidents.(See page 3 in this newsletter for more details.)

Mayor Adams has recently announced his own housing proposal named "City of Yes for Housing Opportunity". The Mayor's proposal, which calls for 100,000 new housing units over 15 years, includes many of the proposals from Governor Hochul plan from last year that includes accessory dwelling units (ADU), calls for mandates for new housing developments, creating a Universal Affordability Preference program, legalizing "main street apartment builds", and modest shared living spaces in new complexes. The Mayor's plan, addressing the continued shortage of affordable housing and the existence of many illegal dwellings in New York City, will propose changing zoning laws to achieve his housing initiatives.

Our civic will conduct its annual election for new officers to serve in 2024 at this month's meeting. I am looking forward to seeing everyone there on Wednesday, October 18, at 7:30 PM, in Our Lady of Lourdes School Building Bethsaida Spirituality Center at 92-70 220 Street.


105th PRECINCT NEIGHBORHOOD POLICING

THE CREEDMOOR HUMANITARIAN EMERGENCY RESPONSE AND RELIEF CENTER

The federal government announced in September that it would redesignate Temporary Protected Status (TPS) for Venezuelan asylum seekers who arrived in the United States on and before July 31 or have resided here since. With that status, the migrants will be eligible to apply to work immediately. Under TPS, asylum seekers can apply to be authorized to work after 30 days as opposed to 180 days in the United States. The Department of Homeland Security extended that status for 18 months.

About 40 percent of migrants who have come to New York City are from Venezuela; more than 116,000 migrants have arrived in the city since spring 2022.

Recently, Mayor Eric Adams cut the time that adult migrants can stay at city-run shelters in half on Friday – decreasing the maximum stay from 60 days to 30 days to get a handle on the constant influx of asylum seekers into the City.

The 105th Pct has two officers 24/7 at the entrance and NCOs are giving the site special attention. The children's playground near PS 18 is being monitored by the 105th and adults without a kid are not allowed in the park.

OUR LADY OF LOURDES FOOD PANTRY

Our lady of Lourdes Pantry is appealing for help as everyday living becomes more challenging. The pantry provides food products for many families in the community each week and the numbers are increasing. Non-perishable food items can be dropped off at the pantry entrance on 220 street behind the church, Monday through Thursday, from 10 AM to 4 PM.
